

## ST. DAVID'S EPISCOPAL CHURCH Celebrating Connections



The years flank the cross, symbolizing how Christ has remained at the center of St. David's history from its beginning to present.

Numeral 1 represents the west wall which is the last remaining structure from the original building. It is a foundational wall upon which the church was

built.

The arm of the numeral 7 represents 7th Street, the road in front of the Historic Church. The stem illustrates the cross streets going out into other parts of the city while also symbolic of a road leading to the church/light of Christ.



Negative space between numerals 7 and 5 form a heart. Represents 175 "years in the heart" of Austin.

The circle represents the parishioners of St. David's as part of the Body of Christ. It also symbolizes the church as a shining light on a hill in downtown Austin.

The arm and terminal of the numeral 5 represent going out of the church and into the world to share the love of Christ with our neighbors. Also represents ministry to our unhoused neighbors through Trinity Center located at the southeast corner of the church property.
